Jennings: Alvin Edward Hinchee died at the age of 85 in Milton, Florida. He passed peacefully at his home in the presence of his family on Tuesday, May 26, 2015.

He was the son of Duke and Irene Hinchee and grew up in Welsh, Louisiana. He was an LSU graduate and an engineer. He served in the US Air Force, stationed in Germany during the Korean conflict. After his service he was employed by RCA, Sperry Rand, Emerson, and as a civilian of the US Air Force. During his career he worked all over the United States and the world, including Florida, New Jersey, Utah, Alaska, Oregon, Germany, Viet Nam, and the Philippines, his last assignment was in Fairbanks, Alaska; he retired to Florida. He was an avid fisherman and scuba diver most of his life, he greatly enjoyed the outdoors.

He authored several short stories and books including "The Best Part of Growing Up" remembrances of his childhood in Welsh in the 1930s and 1940s. The book was recently published by Friends of the Welsh Museum.

Al is survived by his wife, Nelida Hinchee, his sons, Rob, Mark, and Dan, his brother Ray, as well as numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren. He

was preceded in death by his youngest son Tim.
