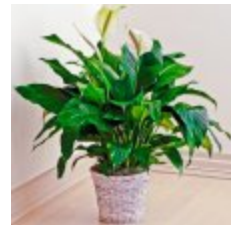

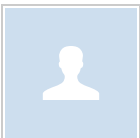

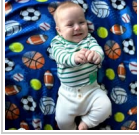

LORD, take care of Arvey. AMEN

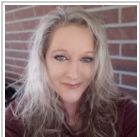
