



Beverly "B Joe" Landry

August 4, 1939 - April 1, 2011

Jennings: Beverly "B. Joe" Joseph Landry, age 71 of Jennings, left this world to be in peace with our Lord on March 29, 2011 surrounded by his loving family. A mass of Christian burial will be held at St. Lawrence Catholic Church in Raymond on Friday, April 1, 2011 @ 10:00 AM with Msgr. Ronald Groth and Father Babasino Fernandes officiating his services. The Landry family requests visitation be observed at Matthews & Son Funeral Home in Jennings on Thursday, March 31st from 3:30 PM - 9:00 PM and resume on Friday at 8:00 AM until the time of his services. A rosary will be recited by Deacon Mike Tramel on Thursday evening at 7:00 PM. B. Joe will be laid to rest in the Raymond-Hathaway Community Cemetery. Beverly Joseph was born in Jennings to the late Dama and Virginia LeBlanc Landry on August 4, 1939. B. Joe graduated from Jennings High School in 1957 and attended the University of Southwestern Louisiana (now the University of Louisiana at Lafayette) where he earned his bachelors degree in civil engineering. He subsequently worked for the LA Dept of Public Works and later the LA Dept of Transportation and Development from which he retired. B. Joe was a licensed engineer and licensed professional land survivor. He held memberships and was an active member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, the Louisiana Cattleman's Association, Jeff Davis Cattleman's Association (also serving on the board of directors), and the National Cattleman's Association. As a landowner, he was a member of the Jeff Davis Rice Farmers Association. After retirement, he served as the consulting engineer for the

Bayou Nezpique Drainage Board. B. Joe was also a devoted parishioner of St. Lawrence Catholic Church Parish and an active member of the 4th degree Knights of Columbus Council 2787 of Hathaway and Msgr. Peters Assembly of the 4th degree Knights of Columbus. He served in several offices of his local council, including Grand Knight and the area councils as District Deputy. B. Joe loved all sports, especially golf. He was an active member of the Jennings Golf Club, the Men's Golf Association, and the "Old Farts Gang". B. Joe married Mary Margaret Bergeron at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Oakdale, LA on May 27, 1961. Their children are Todd Landry and his wife Sandy, Duane Landry and his wife Maureen, Susan Landry Wester and her husband Brent, Daniel Landry and his wife Amber, and Amy Renee Landry Guillory and her husband Brian. He was also the proud grandfather of 18 grandchildren, Ben, Rachael, Eryn, Sarah, Adam, Anna, Patrick, Mary, James, Naomi, Logan, Caleb, and Matthew Landry, Joshua and Brennan LaPorte, and Jacob, Nicholas and Elizabeth Guillory. B. Joe now rests in Heaven with his beloved parents, Dama and Virginia; his only sibling (his sister) Nella Landry Benoit; and his nephew, Joey Benoit. Carrying B. Joe to his eternal resting place will be Ben Landry, Joshua LaPorte, Brennan LaPorte, Jake Guillory, Chris Guillotte, and Mark Bertrand.
