Clifton "Doc" Hanks Gueydan: A mass of Christian burial will be held at Immaculate Conception Church in Morse, LA on Friday, January 13, 2012 at 2:00 PM honoring the life of Clifton "Doc" Hanks, age 90 , who died January 11, 2012, He will be laid to rest in Hanks Cemetery with Rev. Clint Trahan officiating the services. Known to his family and friends as "Doc", he was born on April 30, 1921 in Morse, LA. He was a native of Morse, but a resident of Kaplan at the time of his death. Mr. Hanks served in the Army air force unit during WWII as a part of the Air Offensive in Europe. Upon his return from WWII, he worked as a diesel mechanic for John Deere then later returned to Morse to pursue his love of farming until his retirement. He enjoyed the sport of hunting and loved to cook and bake for family and friends. Doc was survived by his two sons, Clifton Bennett Hanks (Renee) of Houston, TX and Steven P.
