



## Frank Paul "Bubby" Aucoin

Frank Paul Aucoin Jennings: Funeral services will be held at Matthews & Son Funeral Home in Jennings, La on Saturday, March 31, 2012 @ 10 AM honoring the life of Frank Paul "Bubby" Aucoin. Mr. Aucoin will be laid to rest in Greenwood Cemetery with Bro. Charles Provost officiating his services. Frank Paul "Bubby" Aucoin, 70, of Jennings, LA went to Heaven on Thursday, March 29, 2012 at the American Legion Hospital in Jennings. He was born on July 5, 1941 in Lake Charles, LA. He graduated from Jennings High School in 1958. Upon graduation he joined the National Guard, and enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1960. He served a tour of duty in South Korea from 1960-61, and served stateside until 1963 when he was Honorably Discharged. During service he received a Co. Unit Citation, Personal Citation, and Cold War Metal. He worked for Gulf Craft, Inc for 30 years as a Master Shipfitter, welder, shop foreman, and later, as Shipyard Manager of the Simmesport Division until retirement in 2001. In his latter years he volunteered at Jeff Davis VA Clinic and Jeff Davis Living Center. First, and foremost, Frank was a Soldier of the Cross. He was the Pastor of Interfaith Christian Fellowship of Simmesport. He also provided church services for shut-ins, veterans, and nursing home residents, and pioneered the Feed-the-Hungry-Outreach in Simmesport. During his lifetime, he coached Tee ball and Little League, cooked for school sporting events and was known for his barbeque. Frank was preceded in death by his mother, Josephine Benefiglio Aucoin, his father, William Aucoin, Sr., one son, Frank Paul Aucoin, Jr., and brother, William "Billy" Joseph

Aucoin. He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Patricia Ann Clifton Aucoin of Jennings, 2 children: Timothy James Aucoin (Kimberly Miller) of Patterson, LA, and Tina Marie Aucoin Escude' (Wayne Escude') of Eunice, LA 3 grandchildren: Timothy Jacob Aucoin, Sara Beth Aucoin, and Zachary Taylor Aucoin, and one sister: Shirley Marie Aucoin Sonnier of Lake Arthur, LA. He will be sadly missed by all who knew him and loved him. Visitation will be held at Matthews & Son Funeral Home in Jennings, LA on Friday, March 30th from 4:30 PM until 9 PM and resume on Saturday at 8 AM unit the time of his services.
