Visitation will be held 9:00 – 11:00 a.m. in the church. Interment will be in OLPH Catholic Cemetery. Gustavia (“Gus”) was born on November 24, 1921 to Willie and Mary (Richard) Gordon. She returned to our Heavenly Father on October 14, 2013. She was a lifelong resident of Jennings and a member of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church. She was a member of the Sodality and Knights of St. Peter Claver Ladies Auxiliary Court #132 for over 50 years. She worked as a cook for many years. She never met a stranger, was especially fond of children and willing to lend a helping hand to those who needed it, often putting the needs of others before her own. She showed her entrepreneurial skills by operating a snow cone stand. In her later days she began to make and sell cold cups allowing her to come in contact with children and young adults. This provided her the opportunities to encourage them to get an education and to do the right thing. She especially enjoyed reading the Bible and saying the Rosary.
