Hanson served his country honorably in the United States Army during World War II. He was a rice farmer and cattleman before retiring at the age of 86. He had a love for the outdoors and a passion for farming. He could often be seen out in the fields on his tractor working his land in great anticipation for his harvest. Hanson was a member of the Cattleman's Association, Farm Bureau and the American Rice Grower's Association. He was also a member of the Southwest Farm Association, the V.F.W., and a faithful parishioner of Our Lady Help of Christians Catholic Church. He was a wonderful and loving son, husband, father, grandfather, and a friend to so many people. He will be truly missed by all who had been blessed to know and love him. Hanson is survived by his beloved wife, Minerva Sittig Thibodeaux of Roanoke; his son, Brad Thibodeaux and his
