Jennings: It's with the great sadness that the family of Hilton Ray LaSage announces his sudden and unexpected passing from this life on July 7, 2018 at the age of 68. Hilton was born in Jennings, LA to Nelson LaSage and Eva Martin LaSage on January 10, 1950. He was a graduate of Jennings High School Class of 1968. After graduation, Hilton went on to join the Marine Corps. in which he served proudly for twenty years from Sept 28, 1968 to Sept 30, 1988. He retired as a Gunnery Sgt. with countless awards, promotional pins, medals, badges. Even after his retirement from the Marines Hilton remained loyal, devoted, and proud to have served his country, a true "Marine" always. He was commonly known as "Sarge". Upon returning to his home town of Jennings, LA, he acquired a job with Jennings American Legion Hospital, where he was Director of Environmental Services. Hilton was a very dedicated employee for the last 29 years and was still employed there. Hilton was also a member of the American Legion, James O. Hall Post 19, where he was Sgt. at Arms. Hilton was a very dedicated, motivated and inspirational man, as well as a loving father, grandfather, great grandfather, son and brother. He was loved by many and will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.

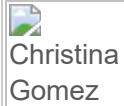

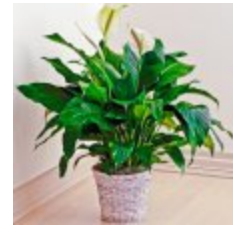

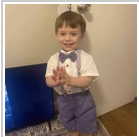
