Howard Warren Seagraves Lake Arthur: funeral services will be held at Lake Arthur Christian Campground in Lake Arthur, LA on Thursday, June 28, 2012 at 2:00 PM honoring the life of Howard Warren Seagraves, age 80, who was called to his heavenly father June 24, 2012 while in the comfort of his home at the campground surrounded by his beloved family. Mr. Howard will be laid to rest in St. Anthony Cemetery where he will be honored with full military rites. Rev. LaMarylis Cotten will be officiating his services. Howard was born in Jennings, LA to the late Sidney Joseph Seagraves and the late Gracie Patterson Seagraves on October 5, 1931. He served his country honorably in the United States Navy during the Korean War. Howard was an engineer (NRECA) for the Jeff Davis Co-op. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church, the American Legion Post 403 in Lake Arthur, and a member of the V.F.W. Post 3244 where he was a Quartermaster and chaplain.
