He made sure everyone was having a good time, paying attention to the smallest details. If someone would ask “When are we going to open the presents?” Or, “When are we going to eat?”, the answer was always, “Ask Allen.”

Everyone who knew Allen liked him. When he met someone new, it was an immediate friendship. We will all miss you, Allen. We already do. And as I close, I just want to say that, Allen, if you’re
