A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, May 6, 2026, in St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church in Gueydan, LA, for Mr. Joseph "Billy" Portié, 76, who passed away on May 2, 2026, at The Calcutta House in Lafayette, LA.

A Visitation will be held on Wednesday, May 6, 2026, at Matthews Funeral Home in Gueydan, LA beginning at 8:00 AM and continuing until his mass time of 2:00 PM. A Rosary will be recited at 11:30 AM.

Joseph William Portié, known to everyone who loved him simply as Billy, was born in Lake Arthur, LA to late Mr. Joseph Portié of Oak Grove, LA, and Mrs. Wilda Kibodeaux Portié of Gueydan, LA. Billy was raised in Lake Arthur and made his home in Gueydan, the town he loved and served for so much of his life. Billy worked offshore in the oil industry for 35 years, a career marked by hard work and quiet pride. After retiring, he became known around Gueydan as the man you could call when something needed fixing — a handyman in title, but truly a helper at heart. There was hardly a corner of town his kindness didn't touch. A devoted Catholic, Billy served faithfully as an usher at

St. Peter's Catholic Church, welcoming his community through its doors Sunday after Sunday. He was also a proud member of the Gueydan Mardi Gras Krewe, riding with only the second krewe ever formed in town, and served as President of Woodmen of the World, where he gave generously of his time and leadership. For the past ten years, Billy was a resident of Gueydan Memorial Guest Home, where he was cared for with love — and where he was crowned King during Mardi Gras, a title that suited him perfectly. Billy loved the outdoors. He was a hunter and fisherman who kept casting a line until illness no longer allowed it. He and Sheryl shared a love of travel, and one of his proudest memories was finally taking his dream trip to Alaska. Just shortly before his passing, Billy and Sheryl celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary surrounded by family and friends — a milestone, and truly a gift. May Billy rest in the peace of the Lord, surrounded by the love he so freely gave.

Billy is survived by his beloved wife of 50 years, Sheryl Matthews Portié; his daughter, Laurel Portié (Christina) of Gueydan; his brothers and their wives, Bobby and Barbara Portié, Ricky and Linda Portié, Lawrence and Beverly Portié, and Kenneth and Cindy Portié; his sister and her husband, Annette and Robert Sonnier; his brother-in-law, Tim Young; and more nieces and nephews than can be counted, along with countless dear friends who will miss him deeply.
