Jennings: A Mass of Christian Burial for Mr. Lawrence Ogden "L O" Briggs, 87, will be held Monday December 21, at 2:00 PM at Our Lady Help of Christians Catholic Church with Fr. Charles McMillin officiating. A rosary will be recited Sunday evening a 7:00 PM. Burial will be in the Calvary Cemetery with full military rites. Visitation will be Sunday evening from 6:00 PM until 9:00 PM and Monday from 10:00 AM until time of service. Mr. Briggs passed away Wednesday December 16, in San Antonio, TX. Mr. Briggs was born September 30, 1922 in Jennings to Lawrence William and Cecile Matherne Briggs. He was a 1942 graduate of Jennings High School, a World War II veteran, an employee of Hughes Tool Company in Houston, Texas and Firestone Tire & Rubber Company in Sulphur, Louisiana. He retired from Firestone after 40 years of service. In 1989, he moved to Conroe, Texas where he resided until relocating to San Antonio, Texas in 2003. He was a member of Operating Engineers Local 407 in Lake Charles, Louisiana, American Legion Post #1 in Lake Charles, 452nd Bomber Group Reunion Association, 8th Air Force Museum Society, and AARP. He attended St. Mark's Catholic Church in San Antonio. Mr. Briggs survived by his wife of 67 years, Irene Istre Briggs of San Antonio; one daughter, Janet Briggs Hale and her husband Jerry of San Antonio, Texas; 3 grandchildren, Jill Hale of San Antonio, Texas, Jennifer Green and her husband Ryan, of Omaha, Nebraska and Jarrett Hale of Dallas, Texas. He also survived by 2 brothers; George Briggs and Norman Briggs of Jennings. Mr. Briggs was preceded in death by
