Mrs. Guinn was called to her Heavenly Father Wednesday afternoon from the Jennings American Legion Hospital where she was surrounded by her loving family. Visitation will be held at Matthews & Son Funeral Home in Jennings, La beginning on Friday, September 25th from 8:00 AM until 10:00 PM and will resume on Saturday, September 26th at 8:00 AM until the time of her service. A rosary will be recited by the Catholic Daughters and the Ladies Altar Society on Friday evening at 6:30 PM. Mrs. Guinn will be laid to rest in Calvary Cemetery along side of her beloved husband, Loyd, following her services. Marcelette was born in Jennings, La to the late Lessan and Olive Valdetero LeJeune on May 21, 1916 and became a life long resident. She became a beautician by trade in 1936.
