Gueydan: A mass of Christian burial for Raoul "Bruce" Broussard, 94, will be held at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Gueydan, La on Saturday, February 27, 2010 @ 1:30 PM with Father Jason Vidrine officiating. Mr. Broussard was called to his Heavenly Father early Thursday morning from the Gueydan Memorial Guest House. Visitation will be held at Matthews & Son Funeral Home on Friday, February 26th from 9:30 AM until 9:00 PM and will resume on Saturday, February 27th at 8:00 AM until the time of his services. A rosary will be recited by Father Vidrine on Friday evening at 7:00 PM. Mr. Broussard will be laid to rest beside his beloved wife, Mildred Simon Broussard, in the Gueydan Cemetery.

Raoul was a native of Kaplan and resident of Gueydan. He farmed rice and raised cattle until retiring at age 72. Raoul loved to hunt and raise horses.
