A memorial service will be held at 1:00 P.M. on Saturday April 15, 2023, at the Gueydan United Methodist Church honoring the life of Richard S. “Dick” Sirmon, Jr.

Dick Sirmon was born on January 6, 1939, in Lake Charles, LA, to Sibyl Sirmon and R.S. “Chick” Sirmon, Sr. He lived most of his life in Gueydan where he was an avid hunter, local rice farmer and taught at Gueydan High School. He loved spending time with friends and family, and always loved to joke around and give everyone a hard time when he saw them, all in good fun. He was a perpetual student who passionately loved learning and teaching others. He was very generous with his time and volunteered where ever there was a need. He served on several mission trips to Russia, at the Indian school in New Mexico, and at Grace Camp for children whose parents were incarcerated. He was a man who truly lived his faith.

Dick was very faithful in his service to The Louisiana United Methodist Cursillo. He loved serving in this organization and rarely missed an opportunity to meet with other friends who felt the same way. He also loved his Masonic Lodge friends. These two organizations helped shape who he was and how he lived his life.

On August 1, 1965, Dick married his beloved wife, Carolyn Cayton Sirmon. Carolyn passed away last year 10 days before their 57th wedding anniversary. Dick was preceded in death by his parents, R.S. “Chick” Sirmon, Sr. and Sybil Sirmon; his sister Diane Sirmon; his in-laws Forrest and Ruth Cayton; and his

wife Carolyn. He is survived by his daughter Amanda Sirmon Fontenot, granddaughter Jordan Fontenot, grandsons Collin and Cayton Fontenot, son-in-law Monte Fontenot, and brother-in-law Keith Cayton (Betty Jeanne).

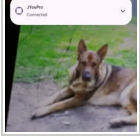
