Winston Lee Broussard Jennings: Funeral services will be held at Matthews & Son Funeral Home in Jennings on Thursday, January 26, 2012 @ 12:00 PM honoring the life of Winston Lee Broussard, age 88, who died January 24, 2012. Winston will be laid to rest in Calvary Mausoleum with Father Charles McMillin officiating his services. Winston who was known to many as "Snook", was born in the Mermentau/Midland area on August 31, 1923. He attended 1st and 2nd grade in Midland then transferred to school in Estherwood where he graduated in 1943. Following graduation, Winston went to work for Southern Pacific Railroad Company as a machine operator. After only working for a few months, he decided to join the United States Navy. He participated in a five week training expedition, then was transferred over seas to Okinawa, Japan for two years. After returning to the United States and Southern Pacific Railroad Company, Winston met his beloved wife Minnie Andrepont and they were married on July 22, 1947. They shared 57 beautiful years together when she died September 6, 2004. Winston was a member of the VFW and American Legion, a member of the FMCA (Family Motor Coach Assn.) and the NCHA (National Camper & Hiker Assn.). He leaves behind to cherish his memory numerous nieces and nephews. Winston was preceded in death by his parents, Adonise and Pauline Schexnider Broussard, his wife Minnie A. Broussard, two brother Ernest and Lee Joseph "Red" Broussard, and one sister Juanita Cailouet.
